







educational programs?





It would be nice to have one CE meeting a year and one networking event. This could be virtual or in person.

I think OHSLA committee chairs needs to regularly let the membership know which committees need more members to help with the workload and to bring in fresh perspectives, as well as what work you are trying to accomplish. I don't think we have done much of that historically. Often our committees were a committee of one.

Opportunities for creative or scholarly activities are needed.

I think fostering more informal collaborative opportunities for knowledge sharing would be beneficial. Possibly at different levels of experience?

I'm a new member, but I didn't know about most of the items in the mission until filling out this survey. It would be great if there was more of the forum/exchange of ideas types of things, rather than jus the two CE classes I virtually attended this year. There didn't seem to be much of an opportunity to get to know people as the new person in this setting.

I think we have gotten away from the aspects of networking that can happen only in person. I think that both virtual and in-person attendance should be provided for each education opportunity. I would like to see OHSLA resume in person meetings.

Another factor that influences my attendance at OHSLA meetings is proximity to or overlap with other events.

I would like to see OHSLA become a little less formal. It's difficult to recruit OSHLA board members and other positions (such as treasurer). I'm in favor of anything we can do to simplify OHSLA while retaining quality CE opportunities through MLA along with networking opportunities. Thank you to OHSLA Leadership for all the hard work you do for us each year!

PLEASE return to in-person meetings.

I think OHSLA needs to develop leadership among the young members. As I get very close to retirement, I feel OHSLA needs young leaders to sustain it.
